### **St. Clair Township Campgrounds - Rules & Regulations Transient Campers**

1. Upon signing of the Daily Permit, the permit holder agrees to and is subject to the rules and regulations, which govern the use of the Campground. Any violation of these rules and regulations shall result in the cancellation of his/her permit by the Campground Lead Hand.
2. Check in time: 1:00 pm Check out time: 11:00 am
3. The Permit authorizes one family to occupy the transient site designated on the permit. There must be an adult of at least 21 years of age accompanying the group on the site.
4. Speed limit in the park is 15 km. maximum.
5. There is a limit of 1 tent and 1 trailer **OR** 2 tents on one site included in daily fee. A fee of \$10 is charged for any additional tent. There is a limit of 2 vehicles per site. (extra fee applies for additional vehicle). Designated parking space for guests is available; please see campground staff for details.
6. Hydro (electrical) service is provided to the main camping unit only. Campground staff reserves the right to inspect, in conjunction with the provincial hydro authority, any electrical service and make any such changes as is necessary to protect persons and property at the full expense of the camper.
7. Alcohol consumption is allowed on campsites only. Campers are not permitted to walk or drive around park with an open beer or alcoholic beverage. Alcohol not permitted in pavillions. Control and consumption must be in compliance with applicable liquor regulations. There will be an alcohol ban on the Victoria Day weekend.
8. Quiet time is at 11:00 pm until 8:00am. If any loud noises disturb you after 11:00 pm contact staff and/or police. No one is allowed into the Campground after 11:00 PM.
9. You are responsible for your guests, parking, kids, pets and knowledge of park rules. Any damage done to Campground property or private property by you and/or your guests shall be your responsibility. Leasee will be charged accordingly.
10. Mooretown Campground: Use of dump station is not permitted between the hours of 4:30 pm - 7 pm. Please try to avoid dumping on weekends if possible. All campers are

required to use appropriate portable sewage tanks. No sewage will be allowed on or to be piped into the ground.

11. Mail or telephone messages (except emergencies) will not be delivered. Check the office for messages on a regular basis. Please advise your guests that if we do not have their name, we will not take messages.
12. The use of fireworks and/or Chinese lanterns will not be permitted anywhere in the park. Anyone who violates this rule will be evicted.
13. Transient campers are permitted 1 “electric” golf cart per site and must have a valid driver’s license to operate cart and must stay on roadway. Additional fee for golf cart is \$5 per day or \$25 per week to be paid at campground office upon arrival.  
**Mooretown Campground:** Bicycles, skateboards, roller-skates, etc. are not permitted on sidewalks, shuffleboard courts or concrete pad in front of office. **No mini-bikes or off-road vehicles allowed.**
14. **Mooretown Campground Pool:** Pool rules and hours are posted and enforced. Use the swimming pool at your own risk since this is a Class B pool. A lifeguard is provided - no entry to pool permitted when lifeguard is not on duty.
15. All pet owners shall ensure that their pet does not make excessive noise or disturb other campers. All pets to be kept on leashes at all times (on or off his/her site). Owners are responsible for cleaning up after their pets. No more than 2 pets are allowed per site. Pets are not allowed in the office, washroom or laundry room. Breaking the rules may result in eviction.
16. The Corporation of the Township of St. Clair shall not be held responsible for theft of property or property damage as a result of fire, vandalism, acts of God, or the actions of other campers.
17. Campground pavilions may be rented at each campground office. Alcohol not permitted in pavilions. Check campground office for rates.

**The Corporation of the Township of St. Clair reserves the right to change, alter, add/or remove any rule or regulation if it is in the best interest of the Campground to do so.**

**Campground management reserves the right to evict any campers who do not comply with the above rules and regulations.**
