Guidance for Arena Users (Parents, Caregivers and Children)

As we continue to open we want to inform all of our users of some of the rules and regulations; these rules and regulations will be strictly enforced by staff and the user groups in which you are associated with.

1. Physical Distancing within the Facility is always required and enforced.
2. We ask that masks or face coverings are worn while in the facility.
3. **Be respectful to the staff always**
4. Each Rental Hour has been permitted 6 volunteers
5. **Doors will be LOCKED when Facility Capacity is at maximum**
6. **Skate Tying:**
 - 1 parent for each skater (U9 & U11 ONLY) to come in and assist with tying skates
 - **Additional children will not be permitted** to enter the facility at this time
7. **Spectators:**
 - 1 parent for each skater
 - **NO ADDITIONAL SPECTATORS** including children and babies are permitted for any reason— Spectator capacity is limited by Public Health and the Province; failure to comply with these capacities will result in the closure of our facility.
 - Spectators who leave the facility for any reason **MUST** be re-screened to reenter; however, spectators may not be permitted to reenter the facility if we have reached maximum capacity for that rental! Staff will **NOT** be recounting between rentals – **ONLY** once staff have cleared the facility for more spectators will the doors be reopened.
8. **Mandatory COVID Officer present at all times during rentals:**
 - Each User Group will designate a person who will be considered that organizations COVID officer
 - This officer will sign in and out with the Complex Participant Screeners.
 - Participants will not be permitted to enter the facility until a COVID designate it in attendance of that rental

Failure to comply with the above rules will result in the following:

1. **You and your participant will be asked to leave the facility.**
2. **A team or group may be asked to immediately leave the facility without refund if rules are consistently not being followed by teams/groups AND individuals.**
3. **A team, group or individual may be suspended for a length of time without refund.**
4. **An individual may be suspended indefinitely from the facility.**
5. **Failure to comply with and of the above rules may result in the retraction of Spectator Allowance.**

We have been working diligently to continue to open and offer more services to our Community – please help us continue to move forward by respecting and adhering to the rules and regulations which we must follow in order to continue to stay open and operating.
